

Village of Lancaster Local Law \_\_\_\_\_ of the year 2023

A Local Law amending Chapter 285 "Special Events" of the Village Code to provide the Town of Lancaster Police Department notice of special event applications.

Whereas the Village Board of the Village of Lancaster desires to provide the Town of Lancaster Police Department notice of and the opportunity to respond to pending applications to conduct within the Village what are defined within the Village Code as "Special Events";

Now;

Be it enacted by the Village Board of the Village of Lancaster, New York as follows:

1) Section 285-3.C.(1) "Approval Process" of Chapter 285 "Special Events" of the Lancaster Village Code shall be amended to read as follows:

The Village Clerk shall review and shall promptly provide copies of the application to the Village Board and to the following for review and comment to the Village Board: the Town of Lancaster Police Chief or his or her designee (hereafter referred to as "Town of Lancaster Police"), the Village Fire Chief, the Village DPW Superintendent, the Director of the Village Office of Emergency Management, the Village Fire Inspector, the Village Special Events Coordinator and the Village Code Enforcement Officer. Unless the Village Board by resolution provides otherwise with respect to a particular application, the Town of Lancaster Police, the Village Fire Chief, the Village DPW Superintendent, the Director of the Village Office of Emergency Management, the Village Fire Inspector, the Village Special Events Coordinator and the Village Code Enforcement Officer shall have 14 days from receipt of a copy of the application to comment. If the Village Board by resolution provides for a time period other than 14 days within which the aforesaid individuals shall comment, the Village Clerk shall promptly advise the aforesaid individuals of the Village Board resolution. If the Town of Lancaster Police, the Village Fire Chief, the Village DPW Superintendent, the Director of the Village Office of Emergency Management, the Village Fire Inspector, the Village Special Events Coordinator or the Village Code Enforcement Officer fails to comment within 14 days or within the time period otherwise set by the Village Board, the Village Board may assume that that individual has no objection to the proposed application.

2) This local law shall become effective the 20th day following its enactment.
