

Village of Lancaster Local Law _____ of the year 2022

A Local Law to repeal § 184-17.B of Ch. 184 “Historic Districts and Landmarks” of the Village Code.

Whereas § 184-17.B of Ch. 184 “Historic Districts and Landmarks” and §350-56.(A) of Chapter 350 “Zoning” of the Village Code are in conflict as to as to whether a site plan review should be conducted by the Village Planning Commission before or after an application for a certificate of appropriateness is decided by the Village Historic Preservation Commission and;

Whereas the Village Board of the Village of Lancaster desires to confirm that, if applicable, the involvement of the Village Historic Preservation Commission should be resolved before a matter is presented to the Planning Commission.

Now;

Be it enacted by the Village Board of the Village of Lancaster, New York as follows:

- 1) § 184-17.B of Ch. 184 “Historic Districts and Landmarks” shall be repealed.
- 2) To accommodate the repeal of § 184-17.B, §§ 184-17.C through 184-17.F shall be recodified as §§ 184-17.B through 184-17.E.
- 3) This local law shall become effective the 20th day following its enactment.
